Q1: About size of sting before and after concatenation:

A: The size of string can be found by using `strlen()`. This function returns number of characters in the string. If you set a larger size for string but the string is short then the rest of the array will contain null value.

Q2: Are Structs similar to Classes?

A: Structs are not essentially classes or provide inheritance functionality. However you can store pointer to functions and variables in structs.
